The Prophet of Islam

With all the fuss about the **cartoons** depicting Muhammed, how much do you actually know about this man who lived in the Arabian Peninsula (present-day Saudi Arabia) some 1400 years ago?

- Muhammad (peace be upon him) was born in Mecca in the year 571 AD. He was of a noble family of the leading Arab tribe.
- He was known for his truthfulness, generosity and sincerity so much so that he was sought after for his ability to arbitrate in disputes. Accounts describe him as a calm and meditative person.
- At the age of 40, he received the revelation from the Angel Gabriel and began calling to the worship of the same one God as did the monotheistic messengers before him - Abraham, Moses, Jesus etc. The revelation was recorded and is known as the **Quran**.
- From the moment he started to preach, he and his followers had to endure bitter persecution and harassment that eventually forced him into exile.
- Throughout his life he retained his simple and frugal lifestyle and in his will he left what few possessions he had to charity.
- When Muhammed died at the age of 63, the greater part of Arabia was Muslim. And within a century of his death Islam had spread to Spain in the West and as far East as China.
